Welcome — your student is about to learn the language of money

Dear Family,

This semester your student is enrolled in S3QUOYAH for Schools, an 18-week personal finance course delivered through Angel-Lena Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. Over six units, students learn what money actually is, how to evaluate any financial decision with a four-question framework, how wealth compounds over time, how modern payment systems work, and how to recognize and defend against scams and manipulation. The course is built to be experienced, not memorized — students barter, simulate, debate, and build their way through every week.

WHAT THIS COURSE IS NOT

- Nothing is ever bought, sold, traded, or signed up for. The entire course is conceptual — no live trading, no investment accounts, no apps, no wallets, and no transactions of any kind.
- No financial products, brands, or platforms are named or promoted in any student material.
- Where modern topics like digital payment systems appear, they are taught as history and concept only — including what went wrong in past failures — never as anything to buy.
- The curriculum collects no student data. It runs on paper and classroom projection — no student accounts or logins exist.

WHAT COMES HOME

Your student will bring home a workbook they build throughout the course. In the final unit, each student prepares a short lesson (about ten minutes) and teaches one money concept to a real audience. Teaching at home — at the kitchen table, to someone they care about — is one option, and it is entirely opt-in: an in-school audience is always available and counts exactly the same. If your student chooses home, your only job is to listen, ask anything, and let them try. Anything they report back is about the teaching itself — never about your family's finances.
